Purpose

This document outlines how to connect to the 'eduroam' wireless network which is available at Maricopa County Community College locations.

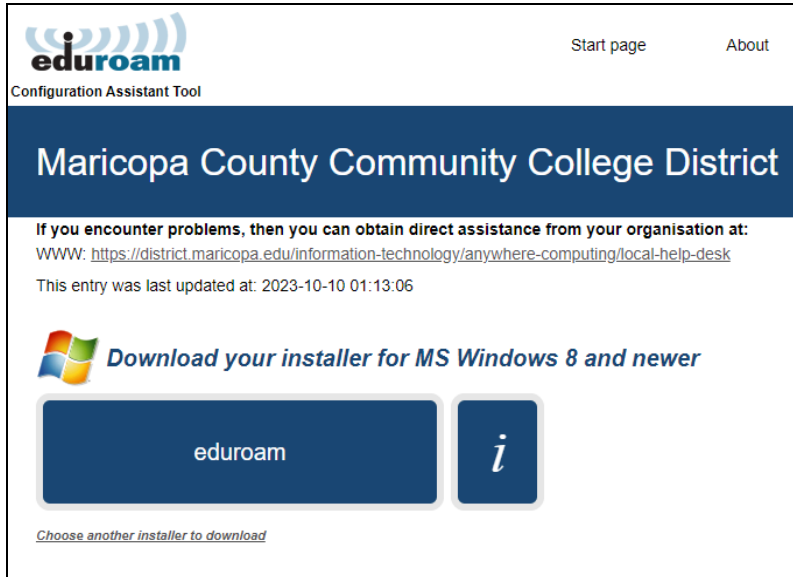
About Eduroam

Eduroam (education roaming) is a secure, worldwide roaming access service developed for the international research and education community. It allows students, researchers, and staff from [participating institutions](#) to obtain Internet connectivity across campus and when visiting other [participating institutions](#) by simply opening their laptops.


Connecting with Windows

Install the Configuration Assistant Tool (CAT)

1. Go to the [eduroam CAT download \(https://cat.eduroam.org/#\)](https://cat.eduroam.org/#) site.
2. Click the 'Click here to download your eduroam installer'
3. When the Organization Window pops up, select 'Maricopa County Community College District'
4. Click on the 'eduroam' button to download the installer.



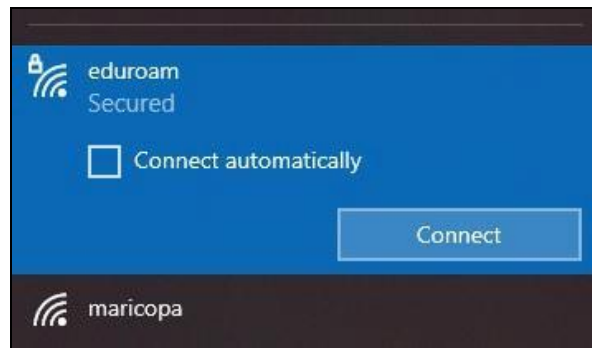
5. Open and run the installer.
6. When the **Welcome to the eduroam installer** appears, follow the onscreen instructions
 - a. Click **Next** to get started.
 - b. Click **OK** to continue with the installation.
 - c. Click **Accept** to accept the terms of use.
 - d. Click **Next** to continue.

7. Enter your Maricopa user credentials
 - a. Enter your **MEID (MEID@maricopa.edu)** in the *username* field.
 - b. Enter your **MEID password** in the *password* field.
 - c. Re-enter your **MEID password** in the *repeat password* field.
 - d. Click **Install** to continue.
 - e. If the **Security Warning** window appears, click **Yes** to install the certificate.
 - f. Click **Finish** to complete the installation.

While at an [MCCCD campus or other participating location](#), search for and select the “**eduroam**” wireless network and click **Connect**. You should now be able to access the internet.



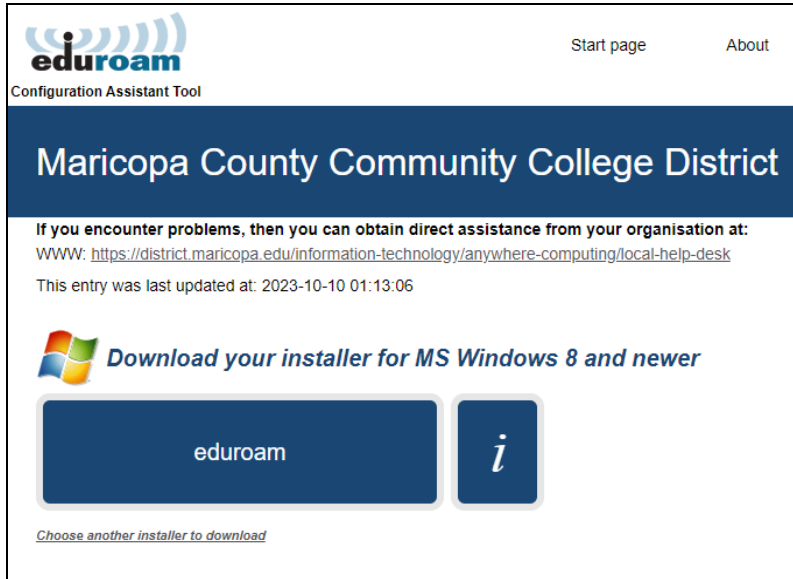

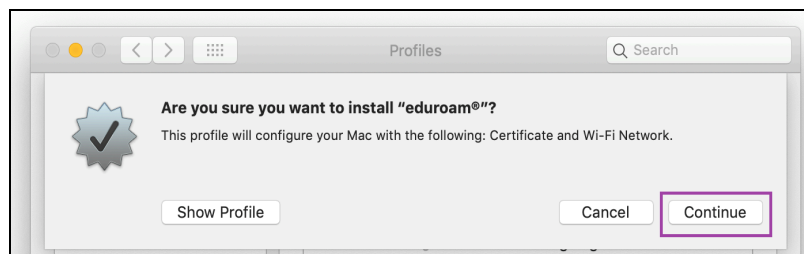
Using Eduroam on MacOS

Install the Configuration Assistant Tool (CAT)

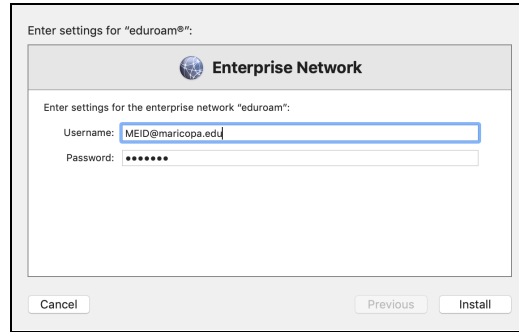
1. Go to the [eduroam CAT download site](#)
2. Click the 'Click here to download your eduroam installer'
3. When the Organisation Window pops up, select 'Maricopa County Community College District'
4. Click on the 'eduroam' button to download the installer.



5. Open and run the installer



6. Click **Continue**
7. When asked 'Are you sure you want to install "eduroam" click **Continue**
8. When prompted to verify a certificate, click **Continue**
9. When prompted "Are you sure you want to install the profile 'eduroam'?", click **Continue**
10. Enter your **MEID@maricopa.edu** in the **Username** screen



11. Enter your **MEID password** in the Enter **Password** screen. Click **Install**.
12. When prompted “**Are you sure you want to install profile ‘eduroam’?**”, click **Install**
13. When prompted that ‘Profiles/MDM want to make changes’, enter your **administrative credentials for your device**. Click **OK**
14. eduroam should now be listed in the Profiles window

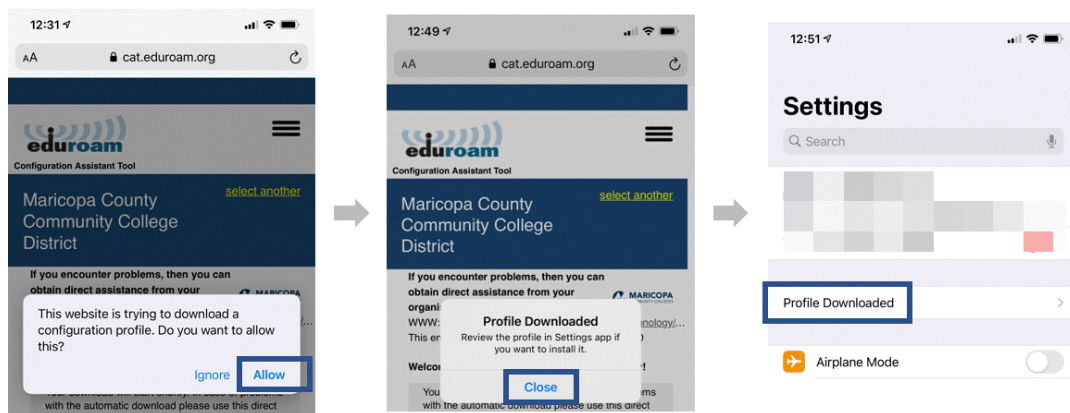
Using Eduroam on iOS

Install the Configuration Assistant Tool (CAT)

1. Go to the [eduroam CAT download site](#) or scan the **QR code** on your device.
2. Tap **Download your eduroam installer** for Apple iOS mobile devices to get started.

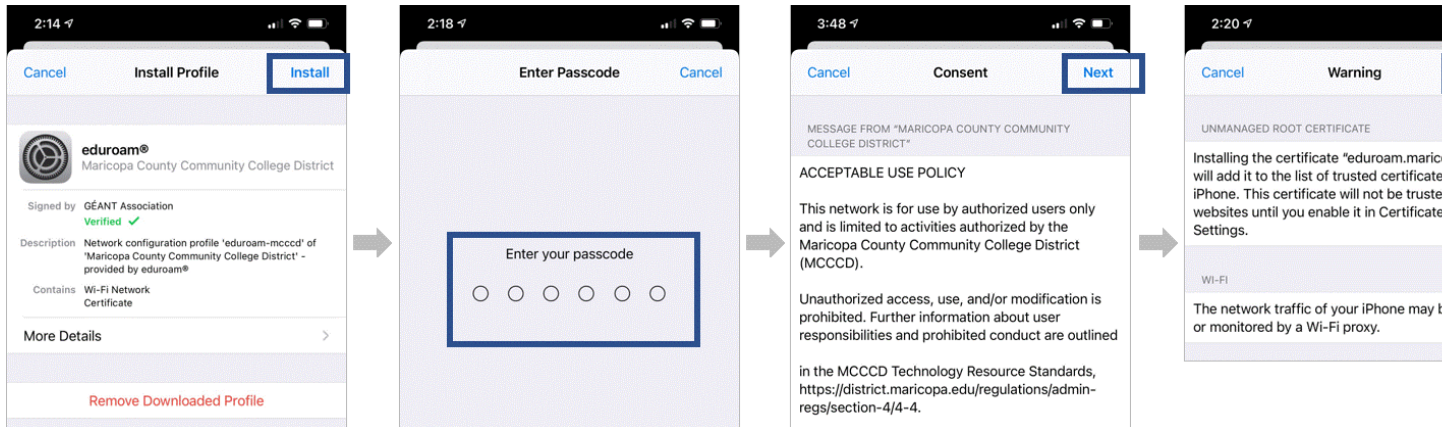


Create the eduroam profile on your device



1. Tap **Allow** to approve downloading the configuration profile to your device.
2. Once the profile has been downloaded, go to **Settings** and tap **Profile Downloaded** to continue.
3. Tap **Install** to install the profile.
4. Enter the **Passcode** on your device.
5. Tap **Next** on the **Consent** screen to accept the terms of use.

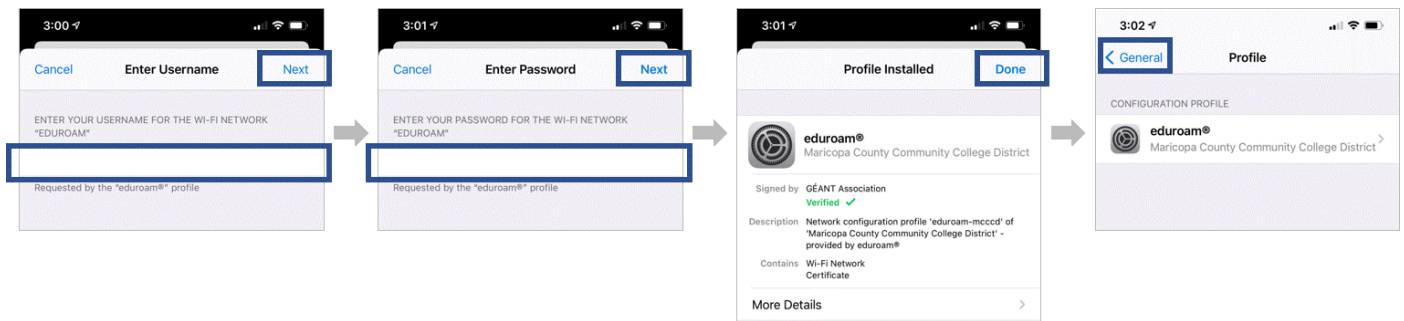
6. Tap **Install** on the **Warning** screen to continue.



Enter your Maricopa account details and complete the profile

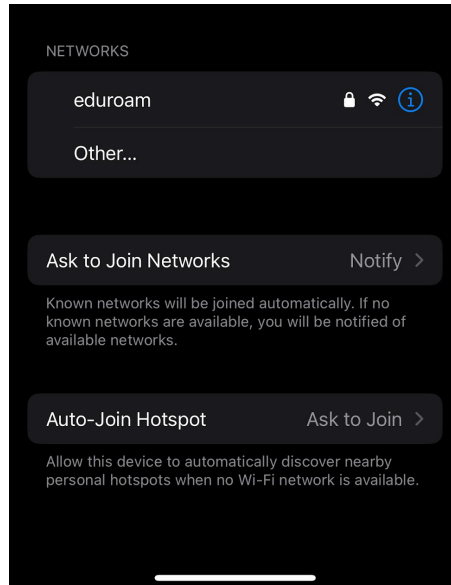
Follow these steps to enter your Maricopa MEID account information.

1. Enter your **MEID (MEID@maricopa.edu)** in the **Username** screen. Tap **Next**.
2. Enter your **MEID password** in the **Enter Password** screen. Tap **Next**.
3. Tap **Done** in the **Profile Installed** screen.
4. The **eduroam** profile will appear on your device's screen.

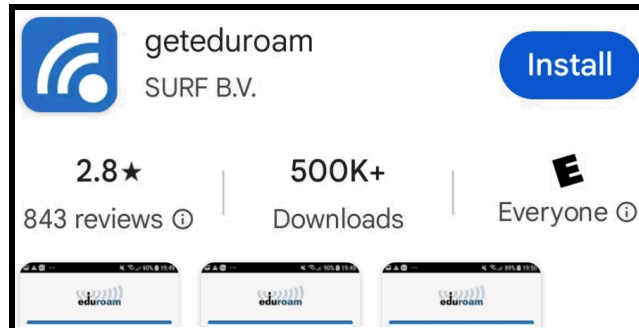

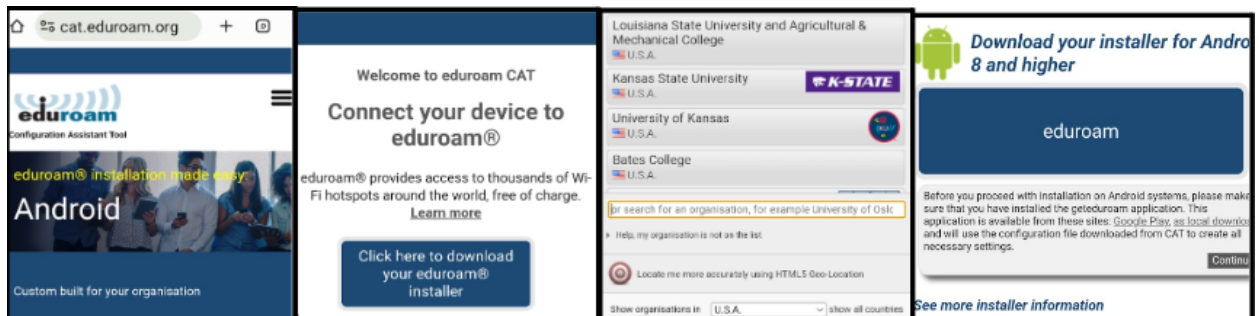
Using Eduroam on Android

Install the Configuration Assistant Tool (CAT)

1. If not installed already, open the Google Play Store on your device and install the “geteduroam” App.



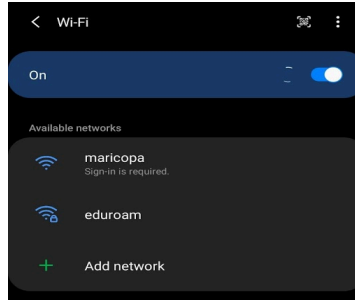
2. On your device, go to the [eduroam CAT download site](#).
3. Click on the button that says **Click here to download your Eduroam Installer**.
4. Search for **Maricopa Community Colleges**.
5. Select **Download your Installer for Android 8 or higher**
 - a. **Important: Make sure you have installed the geteduroam app first**
6. After the file is downloaded click ‘open’ at the top of the screen



7. When prompted to ‘**Allow suggested Wi-Fi Networks?**’, Click ‘**Allow**’
8. When prompted to ‘**Save this network**’, click ‘**Save!**’
