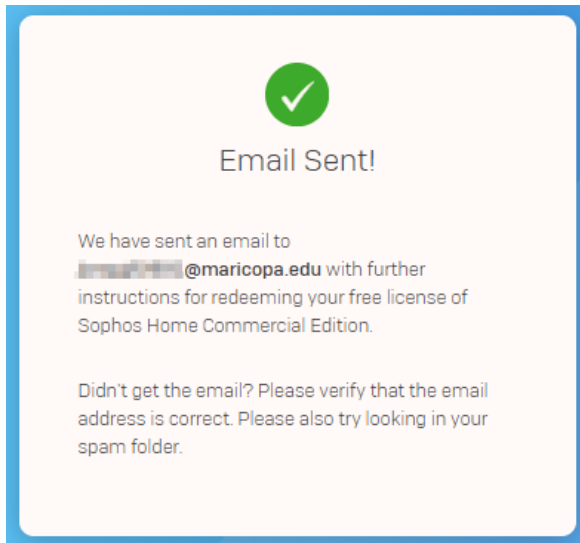

In the Email box, use your student account or employee enterprise account (MEID@maricopa.edu), then click the Submit button.

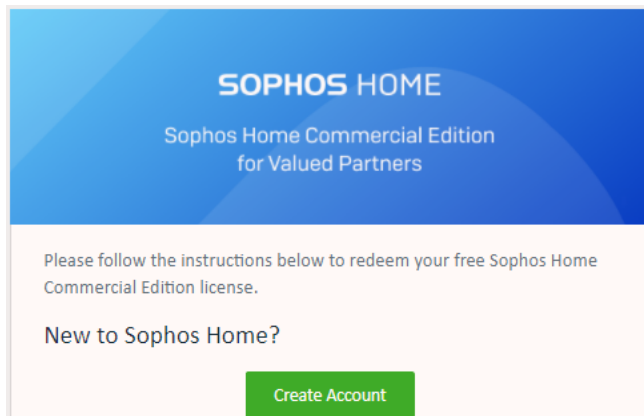

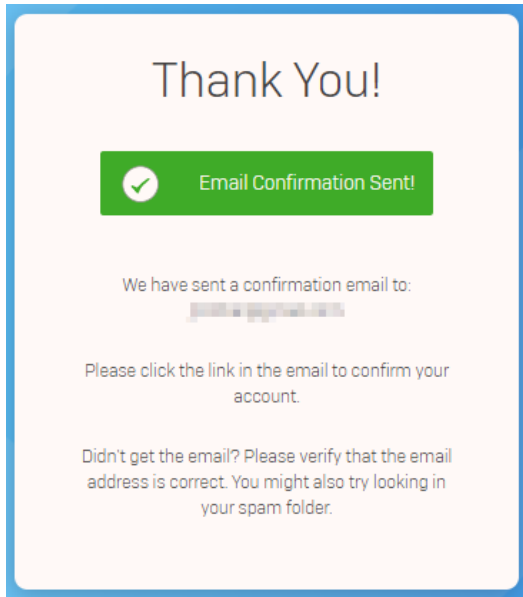
Step 4: Creating Your Personal Sophos Home Account

After entering the requested information, read the acknowledgement, and click the “Create Account” button.

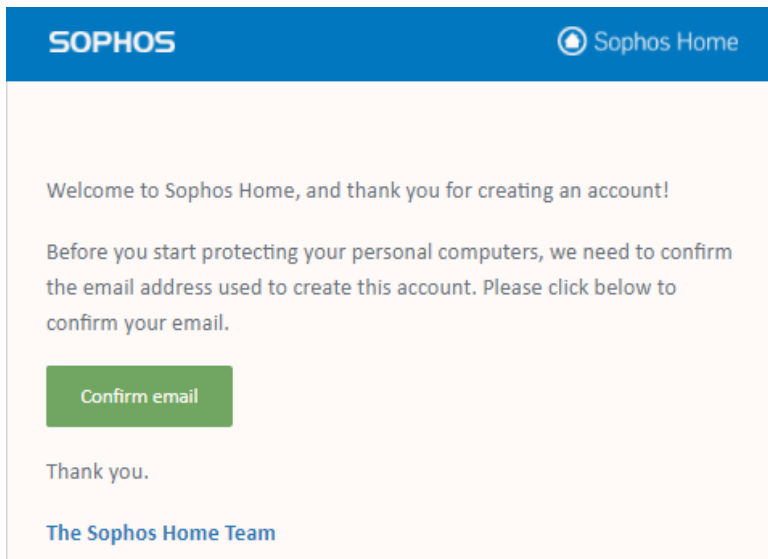
You will see a message that an email has been sent to your personal email account.




In your personal email account you entered above, you will see a new message from Sophos Home with the subject "Sophos Home Confirmation Email."

A new webpage will open for you to Sign In to your Sophos Home account.


